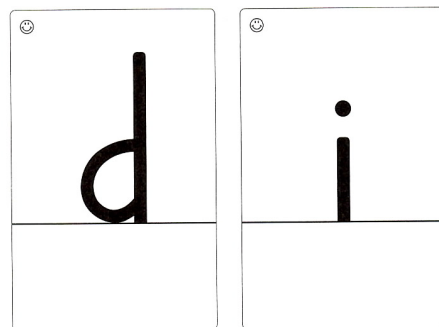
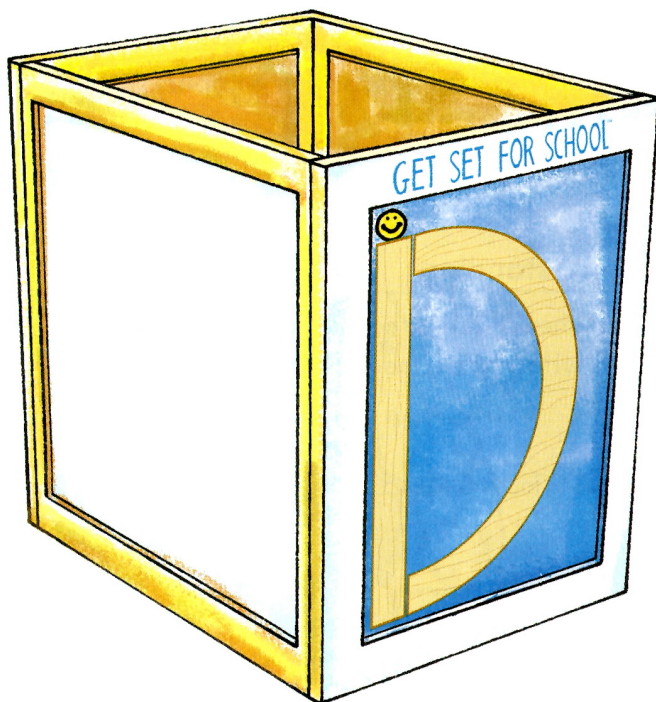


Match Makers
