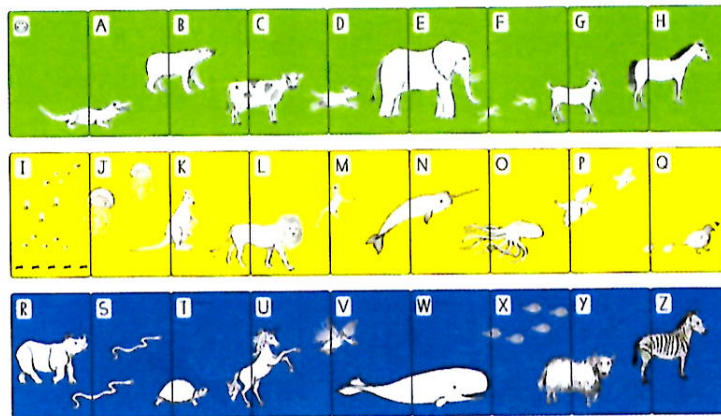


# Alphabet Animals on Parade

The picture side of the A-B-C Touch & Flip® Cards has animal puzzles. Children put the animals together in three lines by color and the animals and letters are in alphabetical order. Flip the cards and the letter side is in alphabetical order too. Children don't even need to know letters to put animals and letters in ABC order.

- Read the animal cards saying, **A** is the first letter in the word **alligator**. Get out ABC animal books and look for animal/letter matches.
